CRITERIA FOR INDUCTION

- 92% cumulative average in Math, Science, English, and Social Studies
- 80% in each remaining academic subject
- Minimum of 25 community service hours
- Successful completion of essay
- No referrals on record
- Completion of application packet by student

- **Leadership**
- **Service**
- **Citizenship**
- **Character**

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Community service is defined as helping an agency or organization fulfill their mission for the betterment of the community
- Volunteers and provides dependable and well organized assistance without financial or material compensation
- Works well with others cheerfully and enthusiastically and renders any requested service to the school
