Dear Parents / Guardians of Seventh and Eighth Grade Students:

As the end of the 2021-2022 school year approaches, I would like to take this opportunity to review grading, testing and end of the year procedures. **These procedures and dates only apply to Grades 7 and 8.** Separate correspondence has been sent regarding dates and procedures for Grades 5 and 6.

Final exams will begin on Wednesday, June 14, 2023.

The June 2023 schedule for seventh and eighth grade final exams and state exams with accompanying bus information will be available on the Middle School's website on June 1. **Please review with your child the bus/testing schedules and identify the bus he/she is to board to expedite our dismissal process.** If you would like a hard copy of the schedules, they are available in the Main Office.

Upon arrival to school on testing days, students will report to their homeroom period for attendance and then be directed to a testing room in order to take their final exam. You are reminded that from Wednesday, June 14, through Tuesday, June 20, backpacks, book bags or totes may be brought to school, however they should not contain any items other than necessary study and test taking materials, etc. Students may also be asked to "check in" their phones as they enter a testing room. The phones will be returned upon completion of their exam.

Textbooks and library books must be returned before the school year ends. Although students are given the option of using their textbooks to help prepare for exams, the vast majority choose review books, study guides, and class notes as a method of study. As a result, students are encouraged to return textbooks to their teachers before the last day of classes. After June 23, please bring the books that your child has not returned to the Guidance Office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

Finally, please be aware that notes must be submitted for students to walk from school on abbreviated testing days. Walking passes will not be issued to students that indicate places of business as the destination. Should you have any questions about the end of the year procedures or activities, please call the Main Office or your child's school counselor.

On behalf of the faculty and staff, I would like to take this opportunity to extend to you and your family best wishes for a restful summer vacation and please encourage your child to take some time to read.
